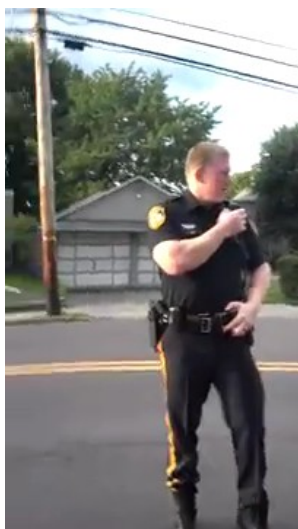


How To Flex Your Open Carry Rights
